St. Frances Cabrini Catholic School Uniform Policy

Visual of What does my child need to Wear?

Please make plans this summer to be ready for the first day of the new school year by purchasing the following uniforms which are readily available at French Toast and Land's End:

PS-2 Girls will wear a round neck khaki jumper with a white Peter Pan blouse. During the winter weather, girls may add dark blue or black leggings under their jumper and a navy-blue fleece hooded sweatshirt.

Grades 3- 8 Girls will wear a two-tab skort with a white Peter Pan blouse and crisscross tie-on Mass days and navy-blue polo shirt regularly. During the winter weather, girls may add dark blue or black leggings under their skirt or navy-blue knee socks and a navy-blue fleece hooded sweatshirt.

PS-grade 2 Boys will wear khaki pants or shorts with navy-blue polo shirts. During winter weather a navy-blue fleece hooded sweatshirt.

Grade 3-grade 8 Boys will wear khaki pants or shorts with navy-blue polo shirts. On mass day a white button-down shirt with navy-blue tie must be worn. During winter weather a navy-blue fleece hooded sweatshirt.

The following information will help make this school year a successful one:

1) Make sure your child attends school every

day and on time.	curriculum if they are not in school. Attendance is one of the most important factors for student success.
2) Ensure your child eats a healthy breakfast prior to attending school daily.	Please encourage your child to eat breakfast at home daily. The mind requires energy to function, just as much as other physical parts of the body. Good nutrition goes along with good learning!
3) Make sure your child completes their homework every evening.	Homework is assigned to give students additional help. It also provides you with an opportunity to participate in your child's education.
4) Attend Home & School Association (HSA) meetings.	We have a very pro-active Parent Association (Home & School Association) who helps provide educational support throughout our school. We encourage you to get involved with this organization and help when you can. <i>Our next HSA meeting is TBA at a later time.</i> Meetings last no longer than one hour. Meetings are typically held the 2 nd Thursday of the month.
5) Please review all materials sent home with your child.	Our teachers and Mr. Gonzales send home important information on a regular basis. Every student will have a "Communication" folder which will hold information such as progress reports, notes from teachers, report cards, etc. Please review them carefully on a consistent basis.
