SUGGESTIONS TO MAKE THIS YEAR A "GREAT YEAR"

The following information will help make this school year a successful one:

- 1) **Make sure your child attends school every day and on time.** Students cannot keep up with school curriculum if they are not in school. Attendance is one of most important factors for student success.
- 2) **Ensure your child eats a healthy breakfast prior to attending school daily.** Please encourage your child to eat breakfast at home daily. The mind requires energy to function, just as much as other physical parts of the body. *Good nutrition goes along with good learning!*
- 3) **Make sure your child completes their homework every evening.** Homework is assigned to give students additional help. It also provides you an opportunity to participate in your child's education.
- 4) Attend Home & School Association (HSA) meetings.
- We have a very pro-active Parent Association (Home & School Association) who helps provide educational support throughout our school. We encourage you to get involved with this organization and help when you can. *Our next HSA meeting is Thursday, September 8th at 3:30 pm.* Meetings last no longer than one hour. Meeting are typically held the 2nd Thursday of the month.
- 5) **Please review all materials sent home with your child.** Our teachers and Mr. Gonzales send home important information on a regular basis. Every student will have a "Communication" folder which will hold information such as *progress reports, notes from teachers, report cards, etc. Please review them carefully on a consistent basis.*

MASS HELD AT ICC ON FRIDAY'S - 8:00 A.M.

We will have weekly mass at Immaculate Conception Church (ICC), which is located at 705 Delaware Street. **Masses will be held every Friday morning, starting August 12th, beginning at 8 am.** Here are some important logistics for this school-wide requirement:

- a) ALL classes/students (with the exception of PreK 3 & 4-year-old program) will be expected to attend mass every Friday.
- b) Because mass begins at 8 am, **you may drop-off your Saint child (ren) at ICC by 7:45 am/7:55 am LATEST**. All our teachers/staff members will be there and waiting for our kids. Our kids will sit with their respective classes and teachers. At the conclusion of mass, all classes will walk back to our school. Please know ALL of our Saints kids will be carefully supervised at ALL TIMES. *For the first few weeks, we will utilize our school van to drive back our kindergarten students ONLY.* As the year progresses, we will evaluate having our PreK 3 & 4-year-old program for future mass attendance.
- c) Saint students who will be participating with our am Extended Care Program, will ride the school van to mass, with the exception of our PreK 3 & 4 year old program. We will depart to ICC no later than 7:45 pm. Students will then be escorted to their respective classes/teachers at ICC.
- d) Please be sure our Saint kids have appropriate mass attire per our uniform policy. (I have had a few inquiries about mass attire and some of you still waiting for items you have purchased. This is not a problem. Have them wear their regular school uniforms.)

As mentioned in previous emails and as part of our unique and Blessed Catholic/Christian school and environment, weekly mass/church attendance and participation are **crucial for our faith and spiritual growth.**
