## From Our Principal

Because 1<sup>st</sup> and foremost from our wonderful and loving GOD, and then from the wonderful and blessed various donations (individuals, businesses, parishes, etc.), fundraising, and effective and careful management and monitoring of STFCCS funds, we want to give you an update of what we’ve (parents/guardians, staff members, board of trustee’s members, and community assistance) accomplished over the past 6 years:

### St. Frances Cabrini Catholic School’s Improvements – Since 2017

- New flooring in main building– abatement conducted.
- Replaced exterior fencing – perimeter of main building.
- Exterior Doors – a total of 11 updated doors replaced throughout the facility.
- In-door painting in all classrooms, hallways, etc.
- Updated & installed new bulletin boards throughout the facility.
- 3 “Sunshade” coverings - main building playground area.
- Playground “chips” for safety measures – both playground areas.
- Replaced 8 classroom doors, including hardware – interior of the main building.
- Replaced toilets in both facilities.
- TV and DVD players in all classrooms.
- Computers for all teachers – K through 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- PA/Bell System installation.
- Artificial Playground Turf installation.
- Sidewalk/entrance cement improvements.
- RO Systems installed throughout facility.

### St. Frances Cabrini Catholic School’s Improvements – 2021-22 Grants

- Purchased Health & Sanitization Supplies, which included: Hand Sanitizers, Lysol Disinfecting Wipes, Lysol Disinfectant & Antibacterial Spray, Clorox Bleach, & Face Coverings – for entire facility.
- Purchased 2 Disinfecting Sanitizer Sprayers, including Disinfection Tablets – for entire facility.
- Purchased 18 Air Purifiers – for entire facility.
- Purchased 70 Chrome Books.
- Purchased 17 Window Replacements – Preschool Building.
- Purchased 3 “Smart Boards.”
- Preschool “Sunshade” Covering Installed.
- Preschool exterior door installations.

### St. Frances Cabrini Catholic School’s Needs

- HVAC Replacements – both heaters and swamp coolers.
- Plumbing renovations.
- Upgrade technology – internet capabilities, wiring, computer upgrades, etc.
- 4 Exterior Doors needs replacing.
- Exterior School Painting – all facilities.
- Security cameras/alarm system.
- Electrical panels updated.

### St. Frances Cabrini Catholic School’s “Financial Assistance”

For the past 6 years, we have been Blessed to average approximately \$12,000.00 given to families who demonstrated financial assistance to help defray with tuition costs. (*Financial assistance is based on FACTS application submissions*) We hope and pray this continues, as the funding for this assistance is not sustainable. It is based on continual support from our community.
