St. Jude Children's Research Hospital "Math-a-Thon" Information

We want to thank you so very much for your help, support, and most importantly prayers, for a very successful "Math-a-Thon" campaign! Because of your efforts, St. Frances Cabrini Catholic School donated a total of \$2,030.00 to St. Jude. (\$1,400.00 was collected through online donations and the remaining \$630.00 was collected via cash and checks.)

Here is more information about St. Jude Children's Research Hospital:

Our purpose is clear: Finding cures. Saving children.

St. Jude is leading the way the world understands, treats and defeats childhood cancer and other life-threatening diseases.

Regardless of the duration or the cost of care, families never receive a bill from St. Jude for treatment, travel, housing, or food, so they can focus on helping their child live.

And we're working to help children worldwide.

Treatments invented at St. Jude have helped push the overall childhood cancer survival rate in the United States from 20% to more than 80% since we opened in 1962.

However, in many developing countries fewer than one in five children with cancer will live. St. Jude is working to change that.
