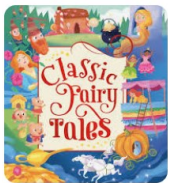


Hello all!

Plus: Moms of every kind are welcome to come browse our first day open and enjoy a muffin or two on us for our Monday, Muffins with Moms!



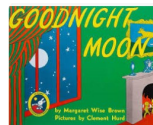
Tuesday, April 30th- Science Fiction Day! Come with your craziest mad scientist hair style!
