planning a Mardi Gras parade for our

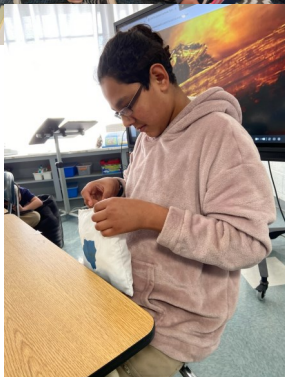
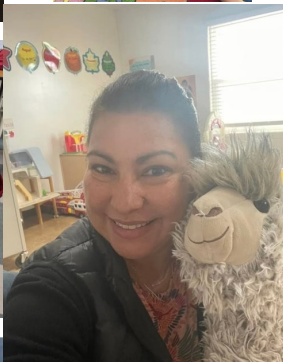
students. The time is yet to be determined but will be during school hours and the

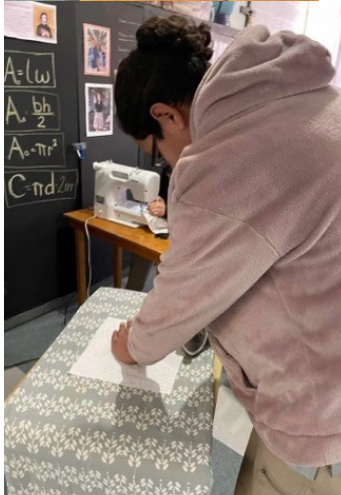
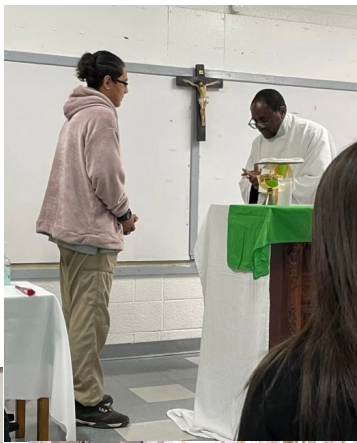

On Wednesday, February 14th, it is Ash Wednesday and the HSA will provide a meat-free pizza lunch for all the students and staff along with a Valentine treat. The Valentine Candygrams will also be distributed on this day.

Friday, February 16th, the Knights of Columbus have generously included our school in their Fish Fry. Each of our students and staff will have lunch provided by them at no cost! They will include us in with their second Fish Fry on March 1st too! Thank you to the Knights of Columbus!
